

Rising Star Education Bursary

The intent of the Rising Star Education Bursary is to give members the opportunity to participate in educational activities that they might not otherwise be able to.

All Rising Star members that are in their 2nd year or more in Pony Club may apply for our Education Bursary. You must not have received Bursary funds in the past year from the Rising Star Bursary fund.

Completed applications must be submitted to DC no later than Feb 1st of the current membership year to be considered.

Members MUST complete the application themselves. You must have had a minimum of 60% attendance at Rising Star Educational events (or approved equivalent) in the previous membership year to be eligible.

All applications that meet the criteria will be considered. The branch executive committee will make up the committee to review the applications (or a committee appointed by the branch executive).

The guidelines the selection committee will follow are on the following page.

The Bursary must be used towards equine educational activities and will be on a reimbursement basis; i.e.; once you have attended a clinic submit the receipt to the treasurer for refund up to the maximum amount of your bursary.

In your application be sure to tell the selection committee how you will be able to give back to members.

Criteria for Education Bursary Applications

Points will be awarded to each applicant as follows:

(e.g., a member in their 6th year in PC that is tested D2 would have 6 points therefore eligible for a max of \$75)

0-2 Points - \$25

3-5 Points - \$50

6-8 points \$75

9-11 Points \$100

12-14 Point \$150

15 Points \$200
