

CPC/NSPC Youth Rep Requirements Consolidated

NS Rules & Regs:

3.3.10 Regional Youth Representative who shall:

- i) be at least 16 years of age at the time of taking office
- ii) be a Canadian Pony Club member of a Branch in the Nova Scotia Region
- iii) represent the views of Active members of the Region and provide a liaison between the Region and all Active members in the Region
- iv) be 18 years of age or older before voting at any Regional Committee or subcommittee meeting.

The Regional Committee in consultation with the Regional Youth Rep may appoint an Assistant Youth Representative who shall not be a member of the Regional Committee. The term of office and method of filling vacancies will be as per section 5.0

Operations Manual-

IX. NATIONAL ACTIVE MEMBER DIRECTORS (new 1998, Revised 2003/2007)

1. The Board has 2 Directors who are Active Members. One must come from east of Manitoba and one must come from west of Ontario.
2. Each Region has the right to nominate one candidate from amongst its Active Members.
3. The nominees will be brought forward to the November SAM and the Board will elect one of the candidates from the east and one from the west.
4. The National Active Member Directors are elected in November, but do not take office until the following January 1. (Revised 2003)
5. If a National Youth Director ceases to be an Active Member, they will also cease to be a Board Member.
6. A nominee for the position of National Active Member Director must have enough years left in P.C. to complete a 2 year term. (Revised 2003)
7. When a National Active Member Director needs to be replaced, their replacement shall be elected to serve the remainder of that term by the Board as per Bylaw 7.02. (Revised Nov.2007)
8. National Active Member Directors must have passed their 18th birthday before taking office. They may be under 18 at the time of their election. (Revised 2003)
9. The Active Member Directors will host a Youth Meeting at National Quiz each year. The organizers of the Quiz are asked to set aside a specific time and location for these meetings. Regions will designate one of their team members to be their official representative to these meetings. (Revised 2003) Organizers of other National Championships are encouraged to run youth meetings at their competition, if interest warrants. (January 2005)
