## **REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

### **ENTRY FORM – Due June 15th, 2010**

Please copy and submit a regional summary page along with as many chaperone and member registration forms as required (one for each chaperone and member). All completed entry forms and fees must be in the hands of the organizing committee no later than June 15th, 2010. Post dated cheques, dated later than June 30th, 2010 will not be accepted.

**Entry Fee:** \$350.00 per participant; \$250 per chaperone. This fee includes accommodations from Thursday until Sunday, activities and meals from Friday morning including breakfast until Sunday late afternoon (only Breakfast and Lunch on Sunday). The participant fee also includes a gift for the horse owner and groom that will be assisting during the competition. Additional pocket money will be required for meals outside of this, transportation to/from the hotel, and other incidentals that the participants or chaperones may require. Make cheque payable to BCIN National Dressage. **NO REFUNDS.**

**Eligibility:** Each region may send one participant per level for 2010 (qualified in 2009) Letters of Intent have already been completed and submitted.

**Chaperones:** All participants under the age 18 must be accompanied by a chaperone; however, a chaperone may chaperone more than one participant with the understanding that the maximum in a room would be four people, but efforts will be made to try to have the rooms positioned in close proximity if a chaperone will be in charge of more than three participant.

### **Clothing:**

T-shirts are available to be ordered at a cost of \$25 including tax – complete the order form included with this registration package. Orders and payment for clothing must be received with your entry form, no later than June 15th, 2010

### **Schedule:**

A tentative schedule is included (more details to follow) by the end of June. Regular updates will be made to the National Dressage information on the CPC website and through email.

### **Supporting Documentation:**

Due to the nature and format of National competition the following supporting documentation is required:

- Letter from DC
- Letter from coach
- Letter from individual familiar with the requirements and the applicant (not a family member) ie competition official, examiner, additional coach/clinician.

All three (3) letters must reference the following: Rider maturity, ability to take direction from a coach/chaperone other than their own and experience riding a horse unfamiliar to them in competition.

- a coach or chaperone's use or possession of illegal or controlled substances or alcohol are prohibited for the duration of any competition and travel involved and will result in disciplinary action.

Any or all of the following steps will be followed in sequence, but there is no time requirement between steps. Beyond Step 2, chaperone will concur. Beyond Step 4, input will be sought from the National Chair of the Discipline, the National Disciplines Chair or the National Chair.

- Step 1. Verbal reprimand.
- Step 2. An explanation and apology to teammates.
- Step 3. Written reprimand.
- Step 4. Elimination from a class or phase of competition.
- Step 5. Disqualification from entire competition.
- Step 6. Removal from a competition site and being sent home early at personal expense.
- Step 7. Presentation at a discipline hearing.
