Not a whole lot to report in the world of dressage this quarter. May 1<sup>st</sup> is the “How to Ride a Dressage Test” lecture. This is presented by the Saskatoon district Cadora and is hosted by Regional PC. Cost was \$5 and \$2 if it's a PC member. Topics covered will include: how the levels work, legal bits, and how to read a dressage test.

Dressage and Show Jumping Championships will be hosted again together. Myself and Dianna are working on figuring out dates. We are looking either July 4<sup>th</sup> or later august/early September. If you have any input on this please feel free to contact me. We hope to improve and be bigger and better then last year. Once we get dates set we will send out a nomination form. This is just to get a estimate of how many members/club are interested in championships so we can set our budget.

We have two riders who are looking at going to Nationals this year to represent Saskatchewan in August. Nationals are being hosted in Nova Scotia. Cost is \$350 per rider, and \$250 per chaperon. We need to decide if we are going to put some funding towards the entry fees/costs/flights of these riders. I believe we voted in a past meeting to cover costs of chaperons for all national events. This looks to be a big event with many entries currently signed up. Confirmation of entries is due at the beginning of may.

Other then that this is all the events I plan for this year. I will be stepping down from my position at the end of this term.

A reminder to parents and clubs that Dressage is a big event still here in Saskatchewan. 3 bronze/gold level shows are hosted each year, as well as several schooling shows in Regina and Saskatoon.
