The Saskatchewan Region Testing Handbooks have been updated and distributed to all of the clubs. Feedback from last year's testings, indicated that the handbooks were a useful tool. Written exam masters for D-C1 have been distributed.

This year clubs are asked to make their own arrangements regarding examiners, but if you would like assistance in this area, or if you have any other questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to email me.

Clubs need to finalize their plans and submit the Test Notification form (in Handbook) to the Regional Testing Chair for approval of the panels. This needs to be submitted two weeks prior to the test date.

Be sure to supply your candidates with the required turnout list for the Horsemastership phase and the flat rides (optional usage).

I have received 8 – C2 applications, 4 – B applications and 3 – B2 Applications. Taryn and Kristen passed their written A exams. Taryn is planning on testing her HA and Tatiana Gabrush her RA this summer. Information regarding the C2-B2 testings will be sent out after the written exams are completed.

C2-B-B2 Written exams are Monday, May 1st at 6:30 pm at St. Gerard School, 205 Montreal Avenue North. Results should be out within two weeks.

As always, keep copies of all testing papers and forms for the club files. ONLY the Branch Test Result Sheet, Test Evaluation by the Club Testing Chair and Test Evaluation by the Senior Examiner should be sent to the Regional Testing Chair within two weeks of the completion of the test. If you have your Horsemastership and Riding separate, please complete the evaluation forms for both tests. The written exams do not need to be copied, but the marks need to be recorded.

Clubs are responsible for verifying cross country clinics and dressage clinic proof in the passports and for supplying members with certificates and discs.
