Arrival: Between 4 & 6pm Friday February 29th, 2008

Departure: No later than 12 noon Sunday March 2nd

Location: MacSkimming Outdoor Education Center, Cumberland, Ontario

Participants: This camp is for all 2008 members of the St Lawrence & Ottawa Valley Region of the Canadian Pony club. Membership with CPC and OEF must be in good standing. This activity is limited to approx 65 members.

Participants will be divided into groups based on their pony club level. Untested and “under” tested members will join a group based upon their current level and age.

Chaperones: Each branch must send at least one chaperone for every four members. Chaperones may join in and make a punched tin lantern where time permits. Each chaperone is asked to indicate the accommodation preference for their group on the Chaperone Application. There is no guarantee to fulfill the preference. It will be on a “first come first serve” basis.

Cost: Participant fee covers tuition, accommodation, a light dinner & snack Friday night, all meals Saturday, breakfast & snack on Sunday morning. Supplies to make tin lanterns & glow sticks included.

The accommodations are Dorm or cabin. The dorms have bathrooms, electricity and regular heat. The cabins are rustic and do not have electricity, bathrooms or a regular heat source. They are heated by wood stove and they must be monitored throughout the day to ensure the cabins stay warm. Our safety officer will assist with this. Washrooms & showers are located at the main buildings.

All participants must bring their own sleeping bag, blankets, pillow, flashlight, towel and toiletries. Showers are available.
