SLOV Regional Quiz 2007 General Rules

Character* Loyalty* Sportsmanship

1. Participants must all be current members of the Canadian Pony Club & OEF or FEQ.
2. All participants must wear a medical armband and a Pony Club Pin at all times throughout the day.

Team Building:

- Teams are made up of members who are within the same age range specified for each level. A member may choose to compete one level higher than their age specifies but they may not compete at a lower level.
- Ideal teams will have 4 members each. If a branch has less than three members in any one level then they may be joined with a team of another branch. If this is not possible a team of 2 may compete.
- There is no limit to the number of teams one branch may register. If a branch has more than one team in the same level they are assigned letters of the alphabet to distinguish them throughout the Quiz.
- Ages are as at Jan 1, 2007. Competition level is defined more often by age.

Levels Explained:

Grasshopper: New for 2007 and is open to "untested" & D level members who are 6 to 8 years old. This group may be assigned a scribe. The activities are visually based. Please note: An 8 year old that would rather be in Level 1 may choose to do so. As a team they will complete a written test, visuals test and three games.

Level 1 – 9 & 10 year olds - Suggested levels untested, D & D1 – Team effort in all phases.

Level 2 – 11 to 13 year olds - Suggested levels untested, D, D1 & D2 – Team effort in all phases.

Level 3 – 14 and up - Suggested levels untested, D, D1 & D2 – Team effort in all phases.

Level 4 – 14 and up - Suggested levels untested, D2, C, C1 – Similar to Level 5 in except all phases are completed as a team.

Level 5 – 14 and up - Suggested levels C & C1 - Written test and visuals are completed individually and games are completed as a team. All team member scores are combined to determine overall team placing. Each individual's written and visual scores are combined to determine individual placing. The top four individual scores will qualify for a place on the SLOV C National Quiz team. (5th place to 8th may qualify, should the Regional committee decide to send two C teams to National Quiz as in 2005)

Level 6 – 15 and up - Suggested levels C2/B/A – written test and visuals are completed individually and games are completed as a team. All team member scores are combined to determine overall team placing. Each individual's written and visual scores are combined to determine individual placing. The top four individual scores will qualify for a place on the SLOV A/B National Quiz team.

Prizes & Awards:

The top team in each level, Grasshopper through to Level 6, will receive a trophy/plaque that will later be engraved with all of the team members' names. These will be ongoing and presented each year. Each individual on the top teams will receive a keeper medal, ribbons will be given to all teams placing 2nd through 6th.

The top individual C and A/B Level will be given a trophy/plaque and keeper medals. Individuals in A/B & C placing 2nd through 8th will be awarded ribbons.

Cancellations & Refunds:

Registration fees are non-refundable. They may be transferred to a replacement team member. A refund may be considered if the participant is unable to attend due to a medical condition that prevented them from participating.

Chaperones and additional Volunteers

Each team of four requires at least one chaperone and each branch is encouraged to send at least two additional volunteers if possible. They will be assigned tasks throughout the day such as time/recorders, room stewards and a variety of tasks involving the games phase. Please send the names of these volunteers with your entry forms and remember to include contact phone numbers or email. Each volunteer will receive an appreciation package.

SLOV Regional Quiz 2007 Games

15 minutes are allowed for each game including instruction time

Grasshoppers

Memory:

- Cards depicting pictures of horse/pony related items are turned face down on the table. Players turn one over and then another, if they match they get a point. If they can tell us what the item is they receive a second point.

Touchie Feelie:

- Items are placed inside socks and they have to guess what it is. One point is given for each correct answer.

Horsing Around:

- Players are shown pictures of horse sports and occupations. They may pass and go to the next picture and if there is enough time left at the end they can retry any they skipped. One point is given for each one they get right.

Level 1

Touchie Feelie:

- Items are placed inside socks and they have to guess what it is by feeling it. One point is given for each correct answer.

Horsing Around:

- Players are shown pictures of horse sports and occupations. They may pass and go to the next picture and if there is enough time left at the end they can retry any they skipped. One point is given for each one they get right.

Memory:

- Cards depicting pictures of horse/pony related items are turned face down on the table. Players turn one over and then another, if they match they get a point. If they can tell us what the item is they receive a second point.

Level 2

Horsing Around:

- Players are shown pictures of horse sports and occupations. They may pass and go to the next picture and if there is enough time left at the end they can retry any they skipped. One point is given for each one they get right.

Pictionary:

- Team members take turns drawing horse related articles. The rest of the team tries to guess what is being drawn. The team may pass on a word and go to the next but are limited to three passes total.

Bridle Path:

- Team members sort out a pile of bridle parts and assemble and put up a bridle. For full marks all parts must match, be assembled correctly, suitable bit for the bridle, be fully assembled and put up correctly. Points are deducted from the total possible score for twisted, mismatch parts or incomplete within the time limit.

Level 3

Horsing Around:

- Players are shown pictures of horse sports and occupations. They may pass and go to the next picture. If there is enough time left at the end they can retry any they skipped. One point is given for each one they get right.

Bridle Path:

- Team members sort out a pile of bridle parts and assemble and put up a bridle. For full marks all parts must match, be assembled correctly, suitable bit for the bridle, be fully assembled and put up correctly. Points are deducted from the total possible score for twisted, mismatch parts or incomplete within the time limit.

Charades:

- Team members act out equine related phrases. The team may pass on a word and go on to the next but are limited to three passes total.

Level 4**Horsing Around & Famous Equestrians:**

- Players are shown pictures of horse sports and occupations. They may be asked to identify an occupation, a sport, a horse, an equestrian, piece of tack, a piece of equipment or a breed. They may pass on a picture and go to the next. If time allows they may go back and retry any they skipped. One point is given for each one they get right.

Abbreviations:

- Players must write the full names for the abbreviations. The answers must be exact.

Charades:

- Team members act out equine related phrases. The team may pass on a word and go on to the next but are limited to three passes total.

The Diagnosis is:

- Players are shown pictures related to horse health and injuries. One point for every correct answer within the time allotted. They may pass and go to the next picture. If time allows they can retry any they skipped.

Level 5 & 6**Horsing Around & Famous Equestrians:**

- Players are shown pictures of horse sports and occupations. They may be asked to identify an occupation, a sport, a horse, an equestrian, piece of tack, a piece of equipment or a breed. They may pass on a picture and go to the next. If time allows they may go back and retry any they skipped. One point is given for each one they get right.

Abbreviations:

- Players must write the full names for the abbreviations. The answers must be exact.

Charades:

- Team members act out equine related phrases. The team may pass on a word and go on to the next but are limited to three passes total.

The Diagnosis is:

- Players are shown pictures related to horse health and injuries. One point for every correct answer within the time allotted. They may pass and go to the next picture. If time allows they can retry any they skipped.
