Entries

Entries will be accepted by email to trevorrecoskie@hurontel.on.ca. Please have entries submitted by November 6th, 2014 to ensure we can make the scramble teams and order the ribbons.



Rules and Regulations

- 1. Each team may consist of 3 or 4 riders (they may be from one club or a scramble team)
- 2. All riders must wear a medical armband, ASTM approved helmet and proper footwear.
- 3. Three refusals in one round is elimination for that round.
- 4. An unauthorized dismount or fall, will be counted as an elimination from that round. Continuation will be at the discretion of the ground jury.
- 5. A course walk will be held before each round.
 A horse may be used in two separate cups if it is with two different rider
- 6. Regional Show Jumping Rules will be referenced in terms of refusals, horse misconduct, false starts, etc.

Scoring

- 1. Rail = 4 penalties
- 2. Refusal = 4 penalties
- 3. There is a set optimum time any time over that is 1 penalty per second
- 4. Each team tallies the top 3 scores per round (if you only have 3 members you do not have a drop score and must take all 3 scores.
- 5. In the case of a tie the winner will be decided on by a coin flip

Reasons to come and participate in the Nations Cup!

- A great way to start the Pony club season! Participate as a team either with your club members or members of another club but you will meet people and have fun coming up with your team name!
- 2. We are having a potluck so please bring something and enjoy some great food while watching your fellow pony clubbers!
- 3. REACH is a big facility and we can watch from the stands, eat in the lounge, warm up in a separate smaller arena and even rent a stall for 10 bucks a day for those horses that would be more comfortable with that.
- 4. An excellent schooling opportunity for you and your horse over two Nations Cup courses. If you have a difficult day you may school after the show over the course for no extra charge. Coaches welcome!!
- 5. Can be used as a qualifier for Regional Show Jumping.
- 6. A great way to practice over Jumper jumps. Jumps that may be included are wall, boxes, flowers, coloured poles, wavy pole, skinny, liver pool, Swedish oxer....etc.
- 7. We will have fun!!
