

WOR Regional Quiz May 10, 2008 Tack & Clothing Sale

As some changes have been made, please read instructions Carefully to participate in this year's tack sale!

How it works: You bring labeled items, we sell them, you get your money minus a 10% donation to the travel fund for our WOR pony clubbers!

What do we bring for sale? A non-exhaustive list is:

- For the horse saddles, bridles, blankets, coolers, saddle pads, bits, reins, shipping boots, splint boots, bell boots, halters, shanks, brushes, etc etc.
- For the rider: jodhpurs, breeches, shirts, chaps, jackets, vests, winter & summer riding boots, books, art, Tetrathlon equipment, PPG equipment, rally equipment, horsey t-shirts and sweat shirts, toys, horse figures, stuffed horses, etc.
- Other – forks, skip buckets, art work, trunks, boxes, saddle racks, books
- Trailers for sale can be parked in the parking lot with for sale sign on them, and a poster put in the tack sale (No, we won't take 10%, but do expect a nice donation to the travel fund if sold)
- By law we **cannot sell used helmets** or live animals!

Instructions:

- Items are to be dropped off in the AM in the tack sale Room #104 (same as last year)
- Please have your items there as early as possible – we're open at 9am
- Bring hangers for clothes
- Tag all items with a tag attached by tied string (masking tape comes off)
- Tag must have your name, Pony Club, and the price (which prices you may mark down through the day at your own discretion). Ex. "Kruger, Mt.Nemo, \$18"
- Be sure to visit the room at the end of the day to a) collect your proceeds of sale and b) collect your unsold items. Everything must be taken from the school – and often the unclaimed items are those without labels anymore because they were poorly labeled (and hence didn't sell because no price was noted!).
- We cannot be responsible for lost or unclaimed items after the sale.

Sale will open at 11:30 am so that volunteers have an equal chance at the sale.
